Rev. Mark Anthony Rawlings was the beloved father of Kathryn and Jessica, (Joseph), and grandfather to Dylan, Sophia & Rebecca.

Mark had a passion for world history, was an avid student of it, and loved to, share historical tales.

He was an active member of the former Montreal United Church Cursillo, Movement and, after first, attending as a "pilgrim", he shared his time as a team member on some of the Cursillo weekends. He was often heard to end conversations with "De Colores!" - a Cursillo greeting in Spanish referring to "the Colours" of God's grace. He loved music, singing and worship.

Mark began to encounter some major health problems in 2014 after which he had to be in an out of hospital in the succeeding years.

May he rest in peace as we honour his love for Christ. As is expressed in the Cursillo movement, 3 days are spent in Christian community on a retreat. The 4th Day is the rest of one's life. And now, Mark rests in the eternal 5th Day.
