## Plymouth-Trinity United Church, Sherbrooke

Plymouth Trinity is accessible from the door on Dufferin Street, with no stairs and a ramp. The door is not automated, but we can keep it open during the time folks are arriving by chaining it open. The meeting space itself is on the same level as the entrance, and we do not anticipate a group large enough to have a "packed-in" feeling.

The biggest challenge is that our truly wheelchair accessible washroom is slightly less roomy now, because we installed a shower stall during the time we were offering sanctuary to a family. It is still roomier than an average single stall bathroom, but it might be tight depending on the size of a wheelchair.

To access the sanctuary there is an elevator which leads from the main hall into the sanctuary (with just enough space for a wheelchair and an accompanying person.)
